



REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS FOR THE 2020 – 2021 SCHOOLYEAR

NEW STUDENTS FOR 2020 - 2021

All new students can register at their catchment school between 9:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. Information regarding the school registration process, along with a downloadable registration form and a checklist of required documentation, is available on the District website at <http://newwestschools.ca/Registration>.

KINDERGARTEN

Children who were born in 2015 are eligible to begin school in September 2020. Kindergarten registration for the 2020-2021 school year begins on Monday, January 13, 2020 at your catchment elementary school. Registrations received after Friday, March 13, 2020 will be accommodated at the student's catchment school as space allows.

IN-CATCHMENT

Registrations for the 2020-2021 school year will be accepted at your catchment school, starting Monday, January 13, 2020, for all students new to New Westminister. Students will be accommodated at their catchment school provided they have registered by 2:30 p.m. on Friday, March 13, 2020. Registrations received after March 13, 2020 will be accommodated at the student's catchment school as space allows.

OUT-OF-CATCHMENT AND IN-DISTRICT

Out-of-catchment and in-district students must first register at their catchment school and then complete an Out-of-Catchment form found at: <https://newwestschools.ca/registration/registration-information-forms/> from Monday, January 13, 2020 to Friday, February 14, 2020. *Note: Admission decisions may not be finalized before 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 5, 2020.*

OUT-OF-DISTRICT
